On the day of the wedding, these arrival times should be observed:

Wedding Party:

Those who plan to dress at the church (typically, the bride and her attendants) should arrive 2 hours prior to the wedding. If you are taking pictures prior to the service, please make sure they begin 1 hour prior to the wedding and only take 15 minutes to complete.

If not dressing at the church and not taking pictures before the service, please arrive 45 minutes prior to the wedding.

Those who arrive at the church already dressed for the ceremony (typically the groom and groomsmen) should arrive 1 hour and 30 minutes before the service. Pictures should begin 1 hour and 15 minutes prior to the wedding and take no more than 15 minutes to complete.

If you are not taking pictures prior to the service, the groom and groomsmen should arrive 1 hour prior to the service.

If groomsmen are serving as ushers, they will begin ushering in the church 45 minutes before the service begins.

Ushers (if other than than groomsmen) should arrive 1 hour and 15 minutes prior to the wedding. They will begin ushering 45 minutes prior to the wedding.

Greeters/Program Attendants should arrive 1 hour prior to the wedding. They will need to be in the church 45 minutes prior to the start of the wedding.

Readers should arrive 30 minutes prior to the wedding.
